10. 'National governments are more effective at promoting development than international agencies.' With reference to two or more Sub-Saharan African countries, to what extent do you agree? [45]

Theme 4: Energy Challenges and Dilemmas

11. 'There is limited correlation between the global distribution of fossil fuels and the global pattern of energy demand.' Discuss this statement. [45]

12. 'A country's energy mix is mainly determined by its physical geography.' To what extent do you agree? [45]

Theme 5: Weather and Climate

13. 'The characteristics of the world's major climate types are the result of global atmospheric circulation.' With reference to **two** climate types, to what extent do you agree? [45]

14. 'The environmental impacts of reaching atmospheric tipping point are likely to be greater than the economic impacts.' Discuss. [45]
